

Information clause on processing of personal data for marketing purposes

1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Habitat for Humanity Poland Foundation with its seat in Warsaw, ul. Grochowska 306/308 building C, 03-840 Warsaw, registered in the Register of associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations and independent public health care facilities of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000143344 (hereinafter referred to as the "Administrator").
2. In matters related to the processing of Personal Data and the exercise of the rights of data subjects, the Administrator may be contacted at: rodo@habitat.pl or by regular mail to the Administrator's address.
3. Your Personal Data is processed for the purpose of sending marketing content (containing, in particular, information about the Foundation's services) to the e-mail address provided.
4. The legal basis for the processing of personal data provided in the form is the legitimate interest of the Administrator to carry out marketing activities (Article 6(1)(f) RODO).
5. Providing personal data is voluntary, however, it is necessary in order to send marketing content to the phone number or e-mail address provided.
6. Personal data can be accessed by the Administrator's employees and subcontractors responsible for, among other things, contacting, handling and sending marketing content, entities providing services to the Administrator (i.e., among other things, IT and technical support) that need to access the data to perform their duties. These entities will have access to the data only to the extent necessary to do so.
7. The period of data processing is related to the purposes and grounds for processing, in connection with which data processed on the basis of the legitimate interest of the Administrator will be processed until you successfully lodge an objection or this interest ceases.
8. You have the right to:
 - request access to your personal data, rectification, deletion or restriction of processing, as well as the right to data portability,
 - withdraw your consent to send marketing content at any time. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the dispatch of marketing content made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
 - in the case where data is processed on the basis of the legitimate interests of the Administrator - the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data.

- to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
9. Your personal data will not be processed by automated means.
